To Parents

Relax! Children are an important part of God's family, and we are happy to have you and your family worship with us today. Here are some tips to make the service a blessing for you and your children.

One of the best things you can do to prepare is to teach your children at home. Each week, we put the upcoming songs on our website. Sing these with your children ahead of time and prepare them at home for what to expect during the service.

during the service, quietly explain the parts of the service and the actions of the pastors and other leaders. Sing loudly, pray with reverence and voice the responses. Children learn by imitating your participation.

If you have older kids, make use of the sermon notes in the foyer to keep your children engaged in the worship service.

If you have an active child, you might need to take your child out of the service part way through. Keep stretching him until he can sit through a whole service. If you have to leave the service with your child, please feel free to do so but please come back. As Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me."

To members and visitors

Children are a gift to our church. They remind us that he is growing his body while raising up the next generation of worshippers.

Let the children know that they are valued members of our church family. Greet them. Love them and at times, bare with them in love.

The Nicene creed:
